What a year 2024 has been! We are profoundly grateful for the Lord's continued guidance and provision over Harvest City Church. This past year, we placed a strong emphasis on groups, recognizing that God created us for connection with Him and with one another. People naturally seek connection, and research confirms what Scripture reveals: without meaningful relationships, individuals are more likely to disengage from a church community. Small groups help create space for genuine relationships, spiritual growth, and lasting connection.

In 2024, we launched our first round of Discipleship Groups, engaging 110 men and women, with a focus on relational mentoring and spiritual formation. We also introduced a new wave of interest-based groups, designed around shared passions such as fitness, creative arts, gaming, dining, marriage, finance, worship, and prayer.

We continue to support 25 organizations, missionaries, and churches actively spreading the Gospel and planting churches across the globe. Our investment in the next generation remains strong through weekly classes, services, special events and conferences.

Knowing that healthy churches are built on strong, biblical leadership, we ordained David Swan as an elder this year. A long-time, active member and trusted leader, David's life reflects the qualifications in 1 Timothy 3 and Titus 1.

Through your faithful generosity, giving at Harvest City reached its highest level to date. Every tithe, offering, and act of generosity reflects your investment in what matters most: the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

The Lord is still building His Church—and His promise remains sure: the gates of hell will not prevail against her. What an incredible privilege it is to co-labor together in God's work on the earth. GOVERNING ELDERS

Harvest City Church is led by the Lead Pastor, Jonathan Clatt, and guided by a Board of Elders/Directors who help shape and steward the church's vision. The Board receives regular updates on ministry activity and church finances and meets with the Lead Pastor at least six times a year. Together, they provide oversight in key areas such as vision and mission, doctrinal clarity, ministry philosophy, staff development, budgeting and financial stewardship, and the overall health and effectiveness of the church. Each elder has been a faithful and active leader for a minimum of ten years, with the longest-serving member, Joe Dejesa, having served for 34 years.

About the Lead Pastor

Jonathan Clatt has served as the Lead Pastor of Harvest City Church since 2015. Before succeeding the founding pastors, Joe and Rose Dejesa, he and his wife, Hera, faithfully led the church's Youth and Young Adult ministries, as well as special events and creative teams. Prior to entering full-time vocational ministry, Jonathan worked as a Marketing and Creative Director. He remained active in consulting for a variety of organizations, including Advisors Asset Management (a Fortune 1000 financial investment firm), Eckard Enterprises (an energy investment firm), Deacon Recruiting, and several other Texas-based companies. He holds a B.B.A. in Marketing from the University of Texas at San Antonio and a Masters of Theology from The King's University in Southlake, TX. Jonathan and Hera met at Harvest City in 1997, became high school sweethearts, and were married in 2007. They have two children, Judah and Jada.

OUR **HISTORY**

1987 Our founding pastor, Joe Dejesa, established the Filipino-American Christian Fellowship (FACF) to reach families within the Filipino community in San Antonio, TX. The church initially met in homes but moved their meetings to Alliance Bible Church to accommodate the growing congregation.

1991 The church's leadership shifted its focus to expand its reach beyond the Filipino community to include all people of different backgrounds, cultures, and ethnicities. The leadership changed the name to Lord of the Harvest Church (LHC) to better position the church for expansion.

1996 LHC purchased six acres in the city off Stahl Road and broke ground on a new church building (our present facility). A year later, LHC began holding Sunday Services and saw 125 people in attendance.

2002 Pastor Joe implement a new vision for the church, emphasizing small groups, evangelism, and discipleship. The church began growing, reaching over 200 people weekly. Our youth ministry began several Bible clubs in public schools and hosted citywide outreaches called Blazing Furnace, with one event having over 750 people in attendance.

2010 Harvest Time Community Church, led by Pastor John Jones, officially joins with LHC.

2015 With a growing congregation of 275, Pastors Joe and Rose Dejesa stepped down as Senior Pastors and installed the Youth and Young Adult Pastors Jonathan and Hera Clatt, who had been with the church since its inception, as the new Lead Pastors. More than 500 people attend the service.

2018 At our Legacy Service, Pastor Jonathan announced to more than 700 people in attendance, with the support of the Board of Elders, that Lord of the Harvest Church would change its name to Harvest City Church to position us for growth and expansion through church planting.

2020 At the beginning of the pandemic, we shifted to online-only services for several weeks before returning to in-person, outdoor services held on our 6-acre property and the Real Life Amphitheater. We made our official return to our building in August.

2021 We celebrated our 30th Anniversary at Embassy Suites Landmark with 575 people present.

Today Today Harvest City Church still exists to bring all people into the life, family, and purpose of God. As we remain dependent upon the Lord to reveal what's next, we will continue to be faithful in the work of making disciples, sharing life together, and creating a kingdom legacy for generations to come.






